The program is comprised of four distinct three-month rotations. In the initial three rotations, clerks are embedded within the respective legal departments at Emera Inc., Emera Energy, and Nova Scotia Power Inc. and will gain exposure to a broad array of legal work, including corporate/commercial matters, employment law, energy law, regulatory and compliance issues, legal operations, M&A transactions, finance matters, and real property affairs. The fourth rotation entails a secondment to McInnes Cooper, offering clerks an introduction to litigation and private practice dynamics.

## **Mentorship through the Articling Clerk Program**

Mentorship is a cornerstone of our program. Each clerk is assigned a lawyer to act as a formal mentor from within the Emera group of companies.
