

Power Line Technician (PLT) Apprenticeship

Making A Career to Make A Difference

Nova Scotia Power's Powerline Technician (PLT) Apprenticeship program is entry pathways for an exciting career as a Power Line Technician with Nova Scotia Power. Every year, our PLT Apprenticeship Program recruits individuals who have completed a Utility Line Worker course, or equivalent, program to join a new cohort of apprentices beginning their careers with Nova Scotia Power.

The Program

Prospective PLT Apprentices participate in aptitude testing, interviewing, and a full-day assessment and evaluation of their ability to perform tasks related to the trade. If successful, Apprentices join an apprenticeship class that is lead by a team of training and trades professionals.

The PLT Apprentice Program is based on a 3½ year apprenticeship program. Nova Scotia Power indentures its PLT Apprentices through the Nova Scotia Apprenticeship Agency.



Your Journey

PLT Apprentices are provided opportunities to learn throughout the province of Nova Scotia and are exposed to a variety of tasks related to the trade, providing them the ability to safely complete work in diverse environments and conditions. Apprentices are expected to live and work in different areas of the province, moving locations approximately once a year during the apprenticeship.

At selected intervals, PLT Apprentices complete 3 additional block releases for their theory training at the Nova Scotia Community College.

At the end of the apprenticeship, apprentices write a final exam for their Powerline Technician Red Seal and are eligible to apply to permanent Powerline Technician opportunities with Nova Scotia Power.
